BROOME COUNTY DWI VICTIM IMPACT PANEL GUIDELINES FOR OFFENDERS

As a part of your case involving drinking and driving violations and/or related offenses, you are required to attend a Victim Impact Panel presentation. You are required to be present for the duration of the entire program which will last approximately 1 ½ hours. You must attend ONE of the Victim Impact Panel presentations scheduled:

GUIDE LINES:

1. You **MUST** be in the classroom by 6:45pm. The door will be locked at 7pm and you will be turned away and referred back to the court if you are late.
2. Check in: you must present a valid I.D., sign in with staff, and pay prior to entering the classroom.
3. You will be required to submit a breathalyzer test prior to entry.
4. Please utilize the restroom **PRIOR** to coming so that there are no interruptions during the presentation.
5. Attendance is for participants only, no children or others allowed.
6. Smoking, drinking, or eating in the classroom will be prohibited for the duration of the presentation.
7. There is **NO SMOKING** allowed anywhere inside of the facility. Smoking is only prohibited outside of the building.
8. **IF YOU ARE SUSPECTED OF USING ALCOHOL OR OTHER DRUGS, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO LEAVE IMMEDIATELY, AND YOU WILL BE PROMPTLY REFERRED BACK TO THE COURT.**
9. No weapons of any kind will be permitted inside of the facility. **IF SUSPECTED YOU WILL BE SUBJECT TO A SEARCH OF YOUR PERSON.**
10. If you leave for any reason, you will not be entitled to reenter or a refund. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
11. If an interpreter is needed, you must notify CVAC and specify what language is needed.
12. You will be asked to participate in a post panel survey so that the V.I.P. Advisory Board can gauge the effectiveness of this alternative sentencing tool.
13. Please turn off all cell phones and other electronic devices during the presentation.
14. In the event of the panel's need for cancellation due to weather conditions, tune to WNBK (1290) & WHWK (98.1) Radio after 4pm or check Crime Victims website at www.cvac.us
